

Data Protection Declaration

1. Validity of Data Protection Declaration for Phoenix Testlab GmbH

The Phoenix Testlab - Data Protection Declaration shall apply to the website for which Phoenix Testlab is responsible. The Phoenix Testlab website may contain links to third party companies to which our Data Protection Declaration does not refer.

Phoenix Testlab guarantees confidentiality of your personal data by

- committing our employees to maintain secrecy,
- ensuring that our safety provisions correspond to state-of-the art technology and
- employing a data protection official for the observation of the Data Protection Declaration.

2. Data that are transmitted by means of Browser/Internet technology

Your visit to our websites is recorded. We register the IP address currently used by your PC, date and time; the browser type and the operating system of your PC as well as the sites you looked at. As a rule, it is not possible to identify a person. These data are only collected for the purpose of data security and for optimizing our competitive offer. Any other evaluation of the data, except for statistical purposes and then always in an anonymized way, does not take place.

3. Evaluation of visitors' behaviour

Phoenix Testlab uses 1x1 pixel tags for evaluating the user behaviour on the websites and for supporting online advertisements. 1x1 pixel tags are small code strings of characters contained in a website. These pixel tags are provided by our partner "Webeffekt". By collecting and analyzing the transmitted data, "Webeffekt" can present the behaviour of the visitors on the Phoenix Testlab website. The presentation especially refers to the various areas of interest of the Phoenix Testlab website and the geographic provenance of the visitors.

If in individual cases an allocation to a certain person were technically feasible (e.g. when you indicate personal data like e-mail address, name or your address via our website) this theoretical possibility will by no means be used.

4. Use of your personal data

The personal data that you give us via a website (e.g. your name, your address or your e-mail address) are only processed in the correspondence with you and only for the purpose for which you provided us with the data. In addition, we will use these data for occasional offers to you to inform you about new services and other performances that might interest you. You may object to this use of your personal data at any time. We assure you that we will not disclose your personal data to third parties unless we are legally bound or you gave us your permission before.

As far as we make use of service providers for realizing and handling processing procedures the contractual relations will be based on the provisions of the Federal Data Protection Law.

5. Your Rights

You are entitled to access the stored personal data on you and also have the right to correct any incorrect data, block or delete them.

6. Secure communication in the Internet

In general, the Internet is considered an unsafe medium. Contrary to a telephone line, for instance, a transmission of data in the Internet can be easier wiretapped, recorded or even changed through unauthorized third parties. To guarantee the confidentiality of the communication with you we use a so-called SSL coding. According to current knowledge the 128 bit encoding provided therewith can be considered secure. This safety level is reached by all browsers of the youngest generation. If need be, you might update the browser on your PC.

7. Update of this Data Protection Declaration

In the event Phoenix Testlab introduces new services, modifies Internet procedures or if the Internet and EDP safety technology further develops, the Data Protection Declaration has to be updated. Therefore we reserve the right to modify or to complete the declaration as and when required. The modification will be published here.
